Information and Facts

Q1: What is SERVE?

- A. A community racket sports facility that will serve youth to seniors, the recreational enthusiast or high performance player.
- B. United States Tennis Association (USTA) has recognized SERVE's unique public/non-profit model as one that will improve and enhance racket sports throughout the entire country!

Q2: What will be the size of SERVE?

- A. The facility is approximately 47000 sq. ft. It will house 6 standard indoor tennis courts (3 will include blended lines for 10 and under tennis, pop tennis and pickle ball) 2 outdoor platform tennis courts, and 2-4 table tennis stations.
- B. Features will include high performance court surface, state of the art lighting, a "welcoming" reception area, functional locker-rooms, and a community classroom.
- C. The mezzanine will provide "open concept" spectator viewing, a snack service area, and an indoor fireplace with conversational seating.
- D. The facility will meet all ADA requirements (including an elevator) and apply "green" initiative guidelines.

Q3: Where will SERVE be located?

- A. On land within Roosevelt Park, the City of Oconomowoc's largest park and home to Imagination Station, the Lake Country Bike Trail Head, and 5 O's Baseball.

Q4: What type of agreement is planned between the City of Oconomowoc and SERVE?

- A. A 50-year ground lease has been approved by the city council, between the nonprofit SERVE entity and the City of Oconomowoc. This is truly a unique public/non-profit partnership.
- B. The Oconomowoc Parks, Recreation and Forestry department will have reciprocal recreational programming opportunities

Q5: Who will operate SERVE and manage the facility?

- A. SERVE is a nonprofit entity that will oversee the organizational structure, financial operation, programming, professional and support staff. SERVE will also oversee all facility maintenance, capital improvements etc.

Q6: Why is SERVE a benefit to the community at large?

- A. SERVE will create an environment that fosters the pursuit of lifetime wellness and fitness, it will respond to the active needs of the Oconomowoc Area School District in addition to the Oconomowoc Parks Recreation and Forestry Department, and provide a valuable asset within Roosevelt Park and areas west of Oconomowoc.
