2018 Public Power Scholarship Program Guidelines

February 2018

Program purposes

- To give something back to the community, contribute to educational efforts
- To increase awareness of public power
- To inform customers about the benefits of having a community-owned, municipal utility

Eligibility guidelines

1. High school seniors may submit essays to win one of two \$1,000 scholarships. To be eligible, the student or their legal guardian must be a customer of Oconomowoc Utilities when the essay is submitted. Dependents of utility personnel are not eligible.
2. Essays should be on the theme: ***The Benefits of Public Power to Our Community***. Essays should be 500-1,000 words, typed, double-spaced and include the following information on a cover page:
 - Student's first and last name; home address; phone number
 - Name of legal guardian
 - Oconomowoc Utilities account information: Name on account; billing address; account number
3. Deadline for submitting essays is ***April 29, 2018***. Please bring your essay to Oconomowoc Utilities or mail it to:
