Please find enclosed Wisconsin Technology Networking, LLC's ("Applicant") Utility Work Permit Application (the "Application") for its proposed new utility infrastructure facilities in the City of Oconomowoc, Wisconsin ("the City"). Along with the attached Application, please also find a set of drawings and sample photo simulation of Applicant's proposed pole.

Applicant is a limited liability company that is certificated by the Wisconsin Public Service Commission. The enclosed Application are for the installation of new "small cell" facilities that will address ever-increasing mobile data demands because they provide coverage redundancy to the cellular network. The greatest demand for mobile data currently exists in the public rights-of-way. These facilities are low-powered, compact, and consist of no ground equipment so that they can be safely and conveniently located in such dense and congested areas and provide the capacity to your residents' devices and applications.

Please note that the Application involves the installation of a new structure with an attachment of "small cell" facilities in connection with Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") licensed or authorized wireless transmission. Consequently, the FCC's "Shot Clock" rules apply.¹ The Shot Clock requires that a jurisdiction act on a request for authorization for such facilities within the FCC mandated time frame, which for purposes of the Application is 150 days from filing.]
