



From the Desk of Mayor Robert Magnus

2022 has been an exciting year for the City of Oconomowoc! Last year the City committed to investing in the growth of the community by creating Tax Increment District #7, which has led to the installation of public utilities, a roadway system and public and private amenities for the redevelopment of the Olympia Fields area. The construction of appropriate infrastructure this year has served as a catalyst and provided development opportunity.

The Olympia Fields improvement has encompassed a considerable amount of residential and commercial activity. The Lochlyn Apartment development continues to attract new residents to the area and provides added consumers to spur additional commercial growth. Commercial activity within the Olympia Fields area is thriving with the attraction of Sendik’s Grocery, Panera Bread, Pet Supplies Plus, a medical office building, as well as a future 8,000 s.f. multi-tenant commercial center.

In 2022, the completion of Wisconsin Brewing Company Park and the inaugural season of the Lake Country DockHounds was a success! The stadium also serves as an attraction for Lake Country residents for concerts, movies, and community events. Oconomowoc also continues to welcome additional residents to the Hackney House Apartments within Pabst Farms, as well as several owner-occupied residential developments throughout Oconomowoc including the Arrowood, Morgan Station and Prairie Creek Ridge subdivisions.

Lastly, quality of life and recreational enhancement projects continue to enrich Oconomowoc through generous donations from the community with the addition of the Ocon Skate Park as well as the Lake Country Pickleball courts. Planning and design is also continuing for future improvements at the John & Lavinia Rockwell Park. The future of Oconomowoc is bright, and we shine as the premiere community to live, work and visit in Lake Country!

When Are My Taxes Due?

Taxes may be paid in full or through the installment plan using the due dates to the right. If you choose to pay by mail, ***it must be postmarked by the Post Office on or before the due date to be considered paid on time.*** If you do not pay by the installment due dates, the entire remaining balance becomes immediately due and is subject to interest and penalties (1.5% per month), retroactive to February 1, 2023.

How Can I Pay My Taxes?

- **Credit Card/Automatic Withdrawal:** Only accepted through online payments. A convenience fee applies.
- **Escrow Check:** Endorse escrow check. Escrow checks made payable to the City must be applied to the entire outstanding balance. If escrow check exceeds amount due a **refund** check will be issued within two weeks.
- **Check:** Payable to **City of Oconomowoc**.
- **Cash:** In person at City Hall. Please do not use drop box or mail if paying in cash.
- **Online Bill Pay:** If paying through your bank, please include **OCOC** with the full tax key number in the customer account field.



Dog & Cat Owners

Please remember that pet licenses are required by state law and expire on December 31st of each year. Pet licenses are required for all pets over 5 months old and are issued by the City. Veterinarians do not issue licenses, but can provide the Proof of Rabies certificate needed to obtain the license. Pets do not need to receive rabies vaccination each year.

How to Apply: Mail or bring required form (available on the City's website), current rabies certificate, fee, and self addressed stamped envelope to City Hall.

License fee: \$15 (not spayed/neutered)
\$10 (spayed/neutered)

Limits: Max of 3 licensed animals per household

By buying a dog/cat license you are funding animal abuse prevention programs in Waukesha County. Thank you for your compliance with the law and for providing funds to protect animals in our community.

Winter Parking Reminder

There is no site where yard waste can be taken to.

Christmas Tree Pickup - Place trees curbside during January 2023 on your regular garbage day. Cut tree in half if they are taller than 6 ft.

 **Household Hazardous Waste** - Saturday, September 9, 2023 @ 630 Worthington St. from 8am to noon. Visit www.waukeshacounty.gov/hazardouswaste/ or call (262)896-8300 for other household hazardous waste sites throughout Waukesha County.

No latex paint accepted at the household hazardous waste collection.

Acceptable Yard Waste Includes:

- Leaves and dry grass clippings
- Yard and garden debris and brush
- Clean woody vegetation material no greater than 6 inches in diameter and not to exceed 4 ft in length
- No more than 60 lbs in total weight

Not Acceptable Yard Waste:

- Vegetables
- Stumps
- Sod, dirt or roots
- Shrubs with intact root balls
- Pumpkins, cornstalks, apples and black walnuts can be included with the regular garbage pickup
- Anything residentially generated

Acceptable Yard Waste Containers:

- 30 gallon paper bags
- Dry cardboard boxes no larger than 3x3 ft
- Other easy-to handle containers no larger than 3x3 ft
- Metal or plastic garbage can no larger than 32 gallons in size and marked with a red X

Placement and Presentation of Yard Waste:

- Curbside and visually separate from refuse and recyclables
- Tree limbs and branches must not exceed 6 inches in diameter and 4 ft in length
- Tree limbs, branches and brush must be tightly bundled and each bundle not to exceed 60 lbs
- Bundle with twine (wire or nylon is not acceptable)
- Plastic bags are prohibited from yard waste collection - they do not compost
- Containers must be marked with a red X to identify them as yard waste
